2. Minimum Foreign Language Proficiency Requirements (optional)

▪ Korean language qualifications - Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) level 2 or higher from the Korea Testing Institute of International Education or Korean Basic 2 or higher from Sejong Institute. ▶ Note: if you have a Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) level 2, you must complete at least 300 hours of language training after admission. ▶ However, applicants in the arts department <u>must</u> have a Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) level 2 or higher or a Sejong Institute Korean Basic 2 or higher. - For students who have completed 4 semesters of the Korean language training course at Mokpo National University, only those who have passed the Korean language proficiency test organized by the university are eligible for admission. ▪ English language requirements - PBT TOEFL 550 (IBT TOEFL 80, CBT TOEFL 210), IELTS 5.5, TEPS 297, TOEIC 700 or higher, or equivalent nationally recognized English proficiency test scores. ▪ Government-invited scholars and foreign government-supported scholars are reviewed separately for eligibility. ▪ All test scores must be taken within two years of the application deadline. ※ TOEFL iBT Minimum Score Requirements - Tests taken by Jan 20, 2026: A score of 59 or higher is required. - Note: Scores are valid for 2 years, with a maximum eligibility period until Jan 20, 2028. - Tests taken from Jan 21, 2026: A score of 3.5 or higher is required.

【 IV. Screening Method and Selection Criteria 】

3. Selection Criteria for Successful Candidates

- A. Applicants who do not meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified regardless of their test scores.
- B. Overseas residents may participate in interviews only if their identity can be verified through video calls during the initial screening. Failure to verify identity through video calls will result in disqualification.
- C. Candidates who are absent from the interview or score less than 60% of the maximum score in the interview will be disqualified.
- D. All scores will be rounded to the second decimal place.
- E. There will be no selection of alternate candidates.
- F. Vacancies resulting from non-registration will not be filled through additional recruitment.

Notes on document submission

1. All application documents/forms must be written in Korean or English.
2. All supporting documents must be legible and unaltered; any unreadable documents may result in disadvantages.
- ※A notarized Korean translation must accompany documents in foreign languages (except English).
3. Information errors/discrepancies, translation errors, spelling errors/discrepancies, etc. in all submissions will not be accepted.
4. The names of the applicant and parents on all documents must exactly match the English names on their passports; errors such as misspellings, omissions, or abbreviations will not be accepted.
5. ※ Overseas residents must submit two copies of all submitted documents for visa issuance after admission.
6. ※ For documents requiring original verification, both the original and a copy must be submitted for confirmation.
7. Additional documentation may be required as needed.

【 VI. Notes to Applicants】

1. Submission of Application Documents: In principle, all application documents must be submitted in person. If you must submit by mail due to unavoidable circumstances, only documents that arrive at the university by 18:00 on the application deadline will be accepted.
2. Original Documents: All submitted documents must be originals. If a photocopy is submitted due to unavoidable circumstances, the original must be presented for verification (the original will be returned after being stamped "Certified True Copy").
3. Translation of Documents: To ensure a smooth qualification review, all documents issued in foreign languages (including English) must be accompanied by a notarized Korean translation.
4. Fraudulent Application: Admission will be rescinded if any information on the application is found to be false or obtained through unfair means. Admission may also be revoked even after enrollment if such facts are discovered later.
5. Return of Documents and Fees: As a rule, submitted documents and application fees are non-refundable. However, if an applicant is unable to attend the interview due to reasons beyond their control (e.g., natural disasters, illness, or accidents), the interview fee may be refunded.
6. Identification for Interview: Applicants must bring a valid ID (Alien Registration Card, Passport, etc.) to the interview. Those without a valid ID will not be permitted to take the interview.
7. Announcement of Successful Applicants: Final results will be posted on the International Affairs website (<https://oia.mokpo.ac.kr/iee/index.do>). Successful applicants must complete registration within the designated period.
8. Maintenance of Foreign Nationality: International track applicants must maintain their foreign nationality until admission. If foreign nationality is not maintained, admission will be canceled.
9. Health Insurance: Students who have not subscribed to international health insurance in their home country are strongly encouraged to enroll in health insurance in Korea (Refer to the Ministry of Health and Welfare's "Health Insurance for Foreigners" guidelines).
10. Multiple Applications: Dual applications to multiple recruitment units within this university are not permitted. However, applying to other universities with different admission schedules is allowed.
11. Visa Issues and Refunds: If entry into Korea is impossible due to visa delays or denials even after the start of the semester, tuition refunds will be processed in accordance with the university's tuition refund regulations.
11. Contact Information: Applicants must provide accurate contact details (phone number, address, email) on the application form. Any disadvantage resulting from a loss of contact is the sole responsibility of the applicant.
 - ※ When completing the application, names must be written in Korean (transliterated), not by their original pronunciation.
12. Unstated Matters: Any matters not specified in these guidelines shall be handled in accordance with the standards separately determined by the university.
