Eligibility for application

1. Eligibility for application

International students whose parents are both foreign nationals, are overseas Korean citizens, or international students who have completed courses equivalent to elementary, middle, secondary and university education in Korea are eligible to apply. All Applicants must meet the following requirements.

(However, applicants to the Department of Nursing must hold a valid nursing license)

2. Language Proficiency Requirements for both Master's and Doctorate Programs

Applicants must meet at least one of the following language proficiency requirements, either in Korean or English:

- **Interdisciplinary Program** : A regular master's or doctorate program co-operated by two or more relevant departments in order to conduct interdisciplinary joint research.
- **Academy-Research Interdisciplinary Program** : A program established by an agreement between the university and a research institute, with the aim of fostering specialists in science and technology. Applicants must be recommended by the head of their respective organization.

※ Departments under 'Note' section operate a master's degree course and doctorate course under different names.

Screening Method & Scoring

1. Screening Method : Interview

※ If, for unavoidable reasons, such as delayed visa issuance, an applicant living abroad is unable to attend an interview, it may be acceptable to hold a virtual interview after verification of identification. Virtual interviews will not be accepted for auditions for the Dept. of Music.
In such cases, evidence, such as a certificate of non-entry of Korea, must be submitted.

3) Screening Methods for Each Category

- The suitability of the applicant's submitted documents will be reviewed
 - During the interview, learning competency, knowledge of major, research plans, academic attitude and ability to express oneself will be assessed.
 - For preparation of interview for the Department of Fine Arts, refer to <Note 3>.
- Applications must be submitted to the department office 3 days before the interview.

3. Selection of successful candidates and rejection processing

1. No quota limit due to recruitment of some people by department (cooperative course)
2. Any of the following persons shall be rejected, and other matters shall be governed by the principle of acceptance determined by the Graduate Committee of MNU
 - 1) A person who is ineligible for document screening (including lack of documents submitted)
 - 2) A person who fails to take an oral examination
 - 3) A person whose oral exam results are less than the criterion for failure (40% of the total score)
 - 4) A person who is found to be different from the fact in which the application is entered (including an error statement) or the documents to be submitted

1. All application documents/forms must be written in Korean or English.
2. All supporting documents must be legible and unaltered; any unreadable documents may result in disadvantages.
3. **A notarized Korean translation must accompany documents in foreign languages (except English).**
4. Information errors/discrepancies, translation errors, spelling errors/discrepancies, etc. in all submissions will not be accepted.
5. The names of the applicant and parents on all documents must exactly match the English names on their passports; errors such as misspellings, omissions, or abbreviations will not be accepted.
6. Overseas residents must submit two copies of all submitted documents for visa issuance after admission.
7. For documents requiring original verification, both the original and a copy must be submitted for confirmation.
8. Additional documentation may be required as needed.

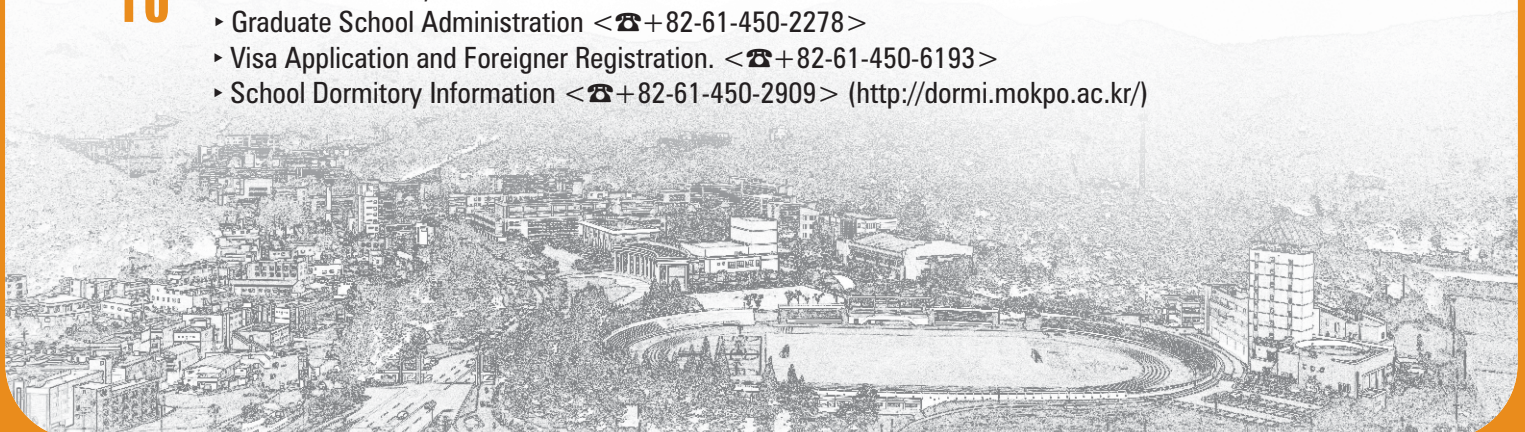

Notes to Applicants

- 01** Applicants must fill in every required field correctly. Applicants are responsible for any disadvantages arising from typing errors, missing documents, etc. Any falsification or misrepresentation in application documents will result in the application being immediately revoked even if the applicant would have otherwise been accepted.
- 02** Since it is not possible to modify or cancel the application form after the application for admission is completed, it is necessary to be aware of the recruitment guidelines and check the information entered before the application is received.
- 03** Applicants can apply for only one department and cannot change the department that they apply for after the documents are accepted.
- 04** Once an application is received, it is assumed that the applicant agrees to their personal information being used for admission purposes. The personal information of applicants will not be used or offered for any purpose other than admission.
- 05** All received documents and application fees will not be returned. If an applicant is unable to finish the admission process for unavoidable reasons such as natural disaster, diseases, accidents, etc., the application fee minus a service fee will be returned.
- 06** If it becomes known that an applicant is ineligible or has falsified information (grades, forged and/or falsified documents, substitute exam-takers, etc.), acceptance or admission will be canceled.
- 07** Admitted applicants must register during the registration period. If not, they are considered to have no intention to enroll in graduate school, and will be treated as a waiver of registration.
- 08** Admission will be cancelled if the applicant is found to be a non-graduate as a result of an academic background inquiry. In this case, the registration fee will be refunded in accordance with the refund policy of the university.
- 09** Applicants should provide correct and current contact information during the period of admission selection. The Graduate School of MNU is not responsible for any results arising from incorrect contact information.

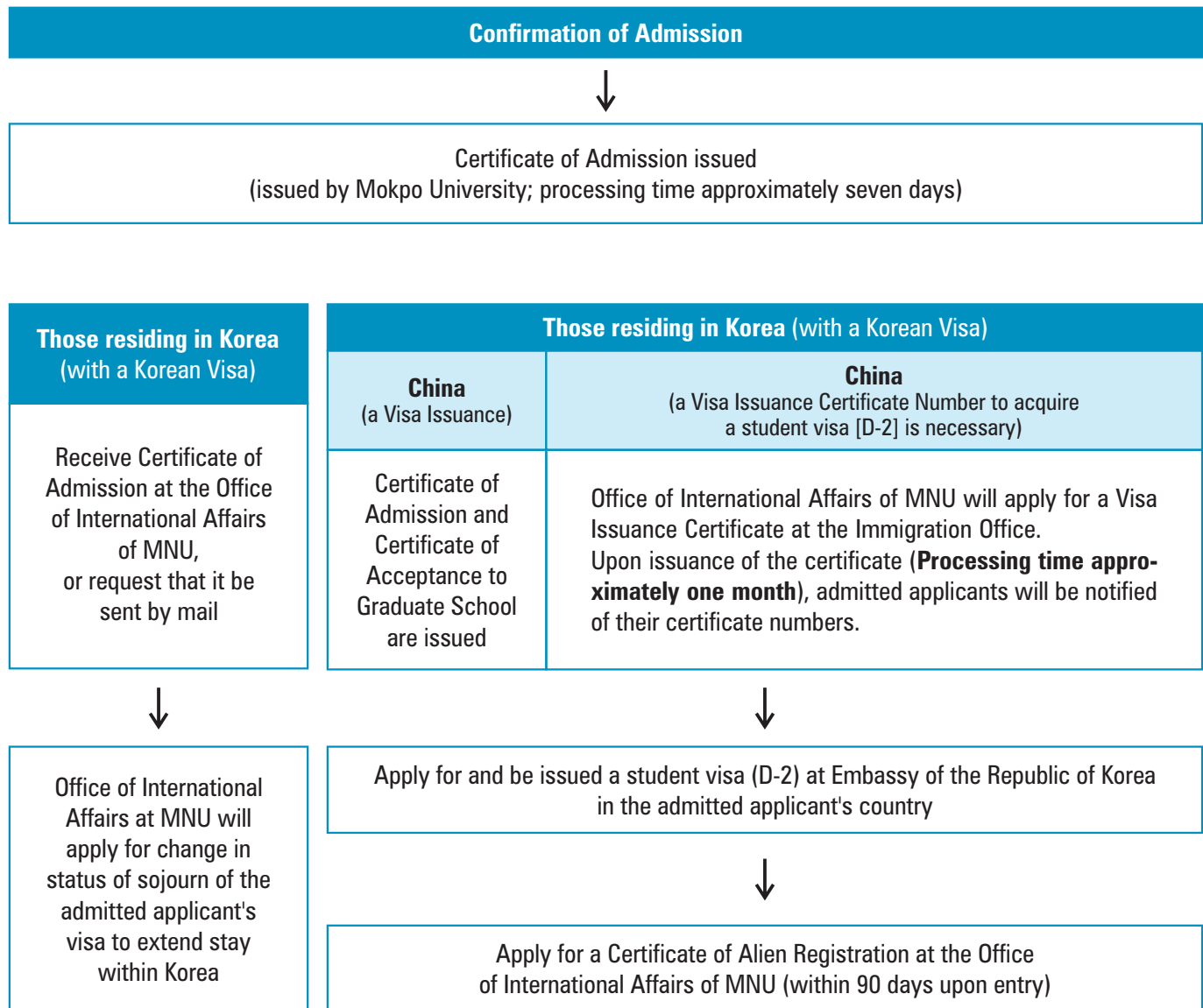
